

YEAR 8 INTO 9 ART SUMMER HOMEWORK

Complete all the following tasks;

- Make a collection of sweet wrappers or images (of cakes, sweets, biscuits, ice-creams) for a collage. Enough to fill an A3 sheet. Cut the pictures out ready to stick down.
- Make a detailed pencil tone study of a chocolate bar at least A4 in size. (Twix, Club, Bounty etc)
- The wrapper should be opened & half way down the bar - take a bite out of the end so you can see inside the bar. Look at the details (crumbly texture? Goopy caramel texture?)
- Get an empty can of pop (Coke, Fanta, Lilt etc) Slightly crush it so that the lettering is a little distorted. Draw 2 detailed observational studies - each A4 in size, each from a different view point & in each in a different materials (pencil tone, pencil crayon, biro, paint etc) Use 2 different cans if you want to.
- Take, & print out, 12 good quality photos of; ice-creams, cakes, biscuits, pastries, pies, puddings & sweets. Any or all of the list.
- In rough make a list of as many as many items as you can for each of the following categories:

Fruit	ice-creams
Vegetables	puddings
Cakes	pies
Sweets	biscuits
Chocolates	

- Bring all of the following in on the first day back - assume you have art that day. We need them in that first lesson to work from.

Art equipment you will need in September;

Essential; good rubber, HB pencil, 2B or 4B pencil, double sharpener, 30cm ruler.

Preferable; set of 12 good quality coloured pencil/watercolour pencil crayons, brushes, small pan of watercolour paints, set of very fine coloured fine-liner pens.
