Wadebridge Sixth Form: Bursaries

What is it and who can claim?

National Bursary

This bursary can be applied for by students whose parents/carers have an income of <u>below</u> £16,190 (before benefits). Students in receipt of Free School Meals will automatically meet the eligibility criteria for the National Bursary. Outside this group of students, financial support will be limited to students whose parental/carer income is below the level needed to qualify for Free School Meals (£16,190) and who are in receipt of a means tested benefit.

Wadebridge Sixth Form Bursary

This bursary can be applied for by students whose parents have an income of <u>below</u>£31,000 (before benefits) and are in receipt of a means tested benefit, such as Working Families Tax Credit.

What is it for?

The support provided for students is intended to meet individual needs to support those young people who would be unable to stay on in education without financial help and is available for costs such as transport, meals, books, equipment, educational trips etc. In addition, the 6th Form HLTA can offer additional study support where applicable. We also have a supply of laptops available for long term loan to bursary students.

How do I Apply?
