

YEAR 8 GEOGRAPHY HOME LEARNING

We hope that this list will help you to help your child with their home learning. We may occasionally set extra tasks, or maybe remove one, but in general this is the plan! Students can use the school library and ICT facilities at lunchtime or after school if needed. We also have a lunchtime homework club on a Thursday in the Geography Department. Autumn Term: What is Poverty?

Students will complete a diary about a day in their life as part of their assessment called Grace's Story that they will be completing in lesson

They will also research reasons why Ghana is a poor country

Students will be completing a comparison project on Ghana and the UK. They will be asked to complete home learning tasks linked to this project.

Students will be expected to undertake some preparation and independent revision for a test on development

Spring Term: Plate Tectonics

Students will be completing an assessment on the eruption of Mt St Helens in lessons. They will be asked to undertake research for this assessment and complete some of this assessment at home

Students will be expected to undertake some preparation and independent revision for a test on tectonic hazards

Summer Term: Coasts

Students will be given a worksheet called 'Off to the Coast' which will ask them to undertake a number of activities linked to the topic studied in lesson.

Students will be expected to undertake some preparation and independent revision for a test on coasts

Summer Term: China

Students will be asked to research and complete some work at home linked to a topic of their choice on China that will also be completed in lessons.
