




WHAT IS THE INTENTION OF CAREERS AT WADEBRIDGE SCHOOL

Young people who are **fully informed** and possess the **skills** to give themselves a chance to achieve their **potential!!**

Types of Qualification on Offer at Wadebridge


GCSE: General Certificate of Education.

- Graded 1 to 9, with 9 being the top grade.
- 100% written examination, apart from in practical subjects, like Art and Drama, where there is an element of controlled assessment (tasks completed under the supervision of the teacher).
- Exams take place at the end of the course (no modules).
- No exam tiers e.g. Higher/Foundation, except in Maths, Science and Modern Foreign Languages.

Technical Awards. Technical awards are an alternative national qualification to GCSEs.

- Equivalent in standard to one GCSE.
- Graded from Level 1 pass to Level 2 Distinction *
- Offer a more applied, skills-based learning route, with a greater emphasis on assessment through controlled assessment (up to 70%), although there will still be some external assessments, for example online tests.
- In most cases there are two opportunities to sit the external assessments (exams) with the best result counting
 in the final grade.
- Offered by established accreditation boards, such as BTEC, OCR, AQA and NCFE.

Can you guarantee students will get what they want?

Options forms show preference and can not be guaranteed

However:

In 2023 only 2 students had to take their reserve subject

No students had to take a subject that was not on their form at all

Reasons we can't guarantee preferences

- To run a subject it needs to have enough students
- Some subjects have large numbers of students and are available on every block so every student can have a place in these
- Some subjects have smaller numbers and we can only offer one class in one block
- If you choose 2 subjects which only have one class in the same block they clash and you will have to choose which you prefer

WHY CAN'T YOU GUARANTEE MY OPTION PREFERENCES

- You pick your option preferences in four blocks, A, B, C and D.
- Each block has two hours in Week 1 and two hours in Week 2 on the timetable.

- You can only take one subject in each block or time slot.
- This is because you cannot be in two subjects at the same time!

- We have to be strict about this deadline to be fair to all students and staff
- We take great care to make student choices work
- Therefore it is very important that you find out as much as possible and take time making choices


