## KIT LIST

*Here is a list of ideas of what you might bring with you on the Paris trip. I would like to emphasise to parents that it is definitely NOT necessary to go out and buy lots of new stuff!*

- Pillow, blanket/sleeping bag for journey
- Wash kit (towels are provided but some people prefer to take their own.)
- Make sure you have enough of any medication you take.
- Clothes - tee-shirts/shirts, jumper/jacket, shorts/skirt/trousers, underwear, socks. (No teeny-weeny crop tops or similar, please!)
- Shoes/trainers/boots that are comfortable enough to spend all day in and to walk in.
- Hat/cap – it can be very hot and sunny.
- Sun cream
- waterproof – be prepared!
- Hairdryer etc (hotel does have them...) - optional
- Camera (& charger or spare batteries) - optional
- Pencil case
- Mobile phone and charger - optional
- Personal stereo – optional
- Games console – optional (as long as it can work on SILENT!)
- Books/magazines etc. (for journey and free time)
- **Continental (2 pin) adaptor plug – if you bring chargers, hairdryers etc.**
- Day bag (small rucksack, or similar)
- Money – in EUROS (you may like to take a small amount of sterling for the journey). Amount optional but about £30 should be sufficient.
- Packed Breakfast/Lunch or money to buy food (breakfast on ferry, lunch stop at service station) on the outward journey. Food will be provided from Tuesday evening meal onwards.
  
- EUROPEAN HEALTH INSURANCE CARD – if you have not yet got this, you can complete a form easily online. THIS DOES TAKE A LITTLE TIME, SO SHOULD BE DONE IN ADVANCE. It MUST be handed to me BEFORE we leave! I will collect them in at the meeting.
