

# History visit to Berlin

19th March - 24th March 2015

## Itinerary

**Saturday 19th March** 08.45 Depart from Wadebridge School (09.00)  
Executive Coach, Travel to Dover.

**Crossing from Dover to Dunkirk DFDS ferries.** Check in at 17.00. Ferry departs at 18.00 arrives in Dunkirk. Arrives in Dunkirk 21.00 French time. Drive through the night on Saturday. Breakfast stop en route.

**Sunday 20th March** - Arrive in Berlin at approximately 09.00

Check into Hotel Arrival for three night's Bed and Breakfast.

Head out on foot. Lunch - MacDonalds, Burger King, KFC

13.00 Museum visit - 'The Story of Berlin' on Ku'Damm, central Berlin.

Walk back to the Hotel. Unpack. Showers etc.

Dinner at Hotel.

After dinner we have use of the Hotel breakfast room each evening.

**Monday 21st March**

Breakfast in the hotel. Make packed lunches from food available at breakfast. Hotel will provide drink, fruit, cake bar and plastic bag.

Coach journey to Topography of Terrors. Self-guided visit.

After the visit the group will walk to Tiergarten Park via Hitler's bunker, the holocaust Memorial and Brandenburg Gate.

Lunch eaten in the park. Coach will pick up at the Soviet memorial and drive us back to Checkpoint Charlie.

14.45 Checkpoint Charlie Museum. Self-guided visit.

17.00 Dinner at Hotel Arrival.

18.00 approx Coach into Central Berlin

18.30 DDR Museum.

Reichstag and Brandenburg Gate at night.

21.15 Return to Hotel.

**Tuesday 22nd March**

08.00 Breakfast in hotel. Make packed lunch as Tuesday.

10.00 Arrive at Sachsenhausen Concentration Camp for visit. Audio guides.

13.45 Leave Sachsenhausen by coach for Central Berlin.

Approximately 14.45 Guided tour of Berlin Olympic stadium

19.30 Dinner at Hotel Arrival

Time to reflect on the visit.

21.00 Packing.

**Wednesday 23rd March**

08.00 Breakfast in the Hotel. Make packed lunches. Pack and tidy rooms. Load coach with luggage.

09.30 am group will head out on foot to the Ku'Damm. Take the U-Bahn (U2) to Potsdamer Plaza then walk to Brandenburg Gate.

From Brandenburg Gate we will walk down Unter-Den-Linden to Alexanderplatz via the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier (Kathy Kollwitz sculpture), Berliner Dom and Radio Mast.

Arrive at Alexanderplatz - students will have time for shopping and lunch.

14.00 Coach pick up for return home to England. Stop for food on the way. TBC
