# **Entry Requirements/Student Suitability:**

Business Studies requires students to express ideas clearly in data response and essay questions. They will also need to possess a degree of mathematical ability to tackle the finance area of the syllabus. Therefore students will need to achieve grade B in Maths and English at GCSE if they intend to study the course.
