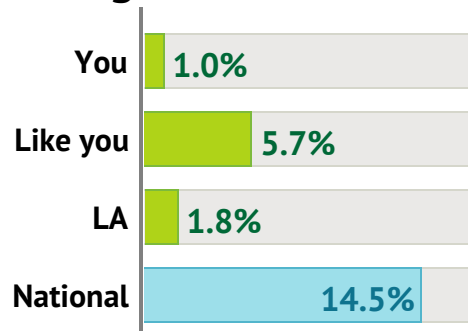

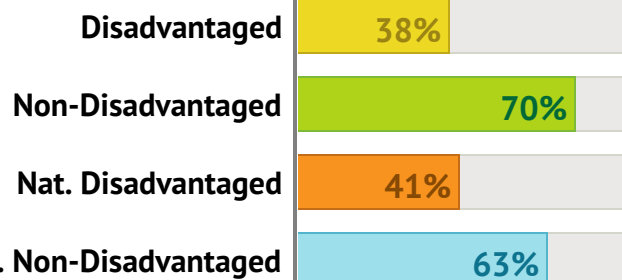

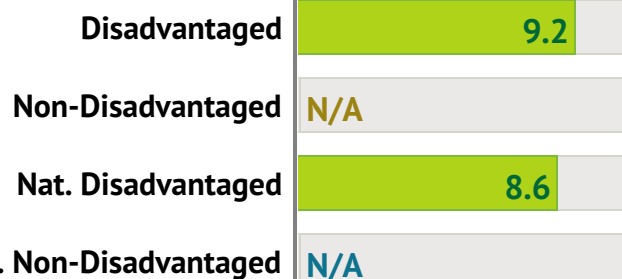

Percentage of EAL students making expected progress in English

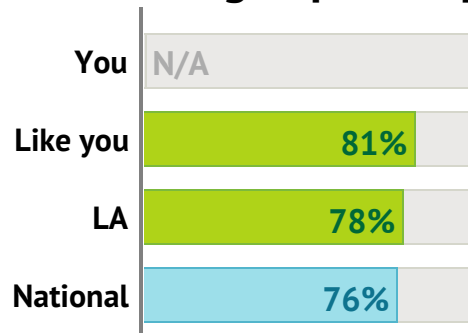

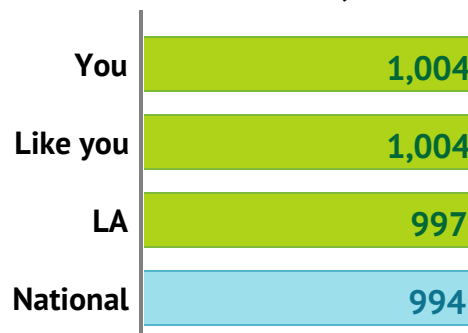

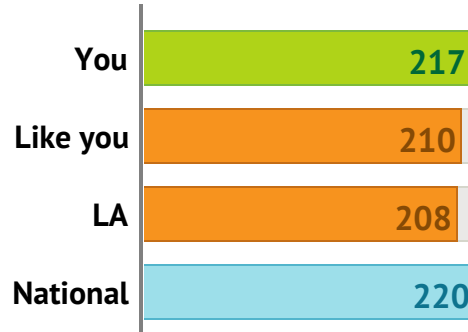

How we did this for Wadebridge

Why create a report?

This report has been created just for Wadebridge to help you to see the power information can have when intelligently analysed, and intuitively presented. It also acts as a small introduction to what Arbor can do. Hello!

How did you get the data?

This report has been created using publicly available information sourced from the Department for Education, Ofsted and Google, which our clever data scientists then imported into Arbor's Adaptive Management System for analysis and output. The result was an individual performance report unique to each school. No two are even remotely alike. Each is special.

How difficult was it to do?

This report used our massively parallel analytics engine, which we've been developing for three years to help schools manage their data. It involved crunching 100 million data points almost instantly to produce 19,320 individual PDF reports, one for every school (who reports their data) in England. From design to delivery took us around a day.

Why do I have some data missing?

We do the best with what we are given, but we're not magicians! Either the data wasn't reported to the DfE, or it was disguised to preserve anonymity, so we've listed it as not available.

What is a school 'like you'?

We created our benchmark of schools 'like you' to give you a fairer way to gauge your relative performance. After all, we know it's harder to get students to the expected level if they come from more challenging backgrounds. So we took your FSM, SEN and EAL data, weighted them 26%, 67% and 7% respectively, based on the size of the attainment gaps at KS2, and combined them into a baseline score to find schools with similar demographic intakes to you. We then chose a group of 100 similar schools around that baseline, 50 directly above and 50 directly below your score, and benchmarked your performance based on this group. This creates a group of schools with a comparable intake whom you can benchmark your results against.

The Department for Education, Ofsted and the Fischer Family Trust all have their own measures of a school like you, as it seems no one can agree (we wish they would)! How do we define 'disadvantaged'?

We use the DfE's most recent definition, which includes looked after children and any child claiming FSM in the last six years.

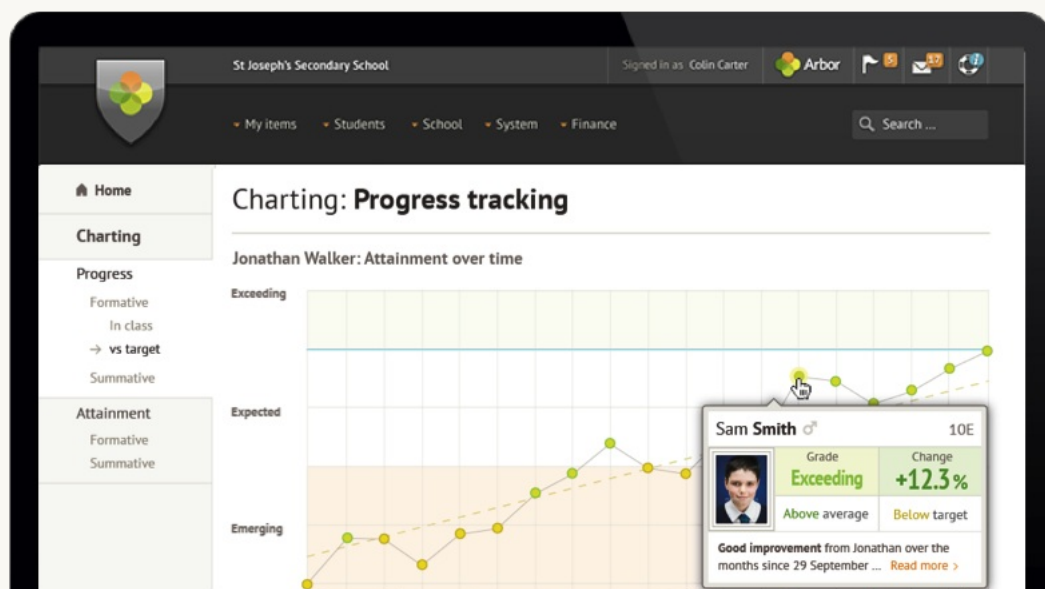
