I am writing to inform you of the arrangements for the forthcoming trial examinations which will begin on **Monday 25th February** and finish on **Friday 1st March 2019**. These trial examinations will run according to the regulations set by the awarding bodies.

If they have not already done so students will soon start constructing a revision timetable during tutor time. Your son/daughter will be instructed to ask for your assistance in identifying family and other commitments that will impact upon their revision time. Students will receive their trial examination grades on **Friday 29th March 2019**. Students will be given the opportunity to reflect on the trial examination experience and discuss strategies for the remaining months of Year 11 in order to secure the best grades for themselves in each subject.
