The Basics!

- When? Week beginning 5th October; each group will go for two days and one night.
- Where? Porthpean near St Austell
- Who? All year 7 pupils will attend
- How much? £65 voluntary contribution



Time table

- Groups depart *after* registration & break.
- JRC and SCN will depart on Monday and return Tuesday.
- DFL and WES will depart Tuesday and return Wednesday.
- TSP and ATB will depart Wednesday and return Thursday.
- DMA will depart Thursday and return Friday.

Daily Plan – Day 1

- Children put bags in underground store
- Lessons 1 & 2 normal lessons (for SCN, WES & ATB)
- JRC, DFL, TSP & DMA leave after morning registration.
- 12:00 arrive, settle into tents, eat packed lunch.
- 13:30-16:30 Afternoon activity
- 17:30 Evening meal (provided)
- 18:30-21:00 Evening activities
- 22:00 go to bed









Daily Plan – Day 2

- 8:00 Breakfast (provided)
- 09:30-11:00 JRC, DFL, TSP & DMA Morning activity then leave. Lunch provided.
- SCN, WES & ATB Morning activity, lunch and then Load coach and depart by 14:00

Activities

- Each pupil will take part in a half day of activities on the beach (either kayaking, canoeing and coastal traversing)
- Each pupil will take part in a half day of land based activities (climbing and high ropes)
- In the evening pupils will do team games and circus skills!

What to bring – for activities...

-  Two complete sets of old clothing suitable for outdoor activities
-  Old trainers/plimsolls/wet shoes for watersports
-  Old trainers or wellies for land based activities
-  Waterproof jacket and trousers
-  Swim wear
-  Sun hat, woolly hat and sun cream

What to bring for the night...

- Personal toiletries and towel
- Sleeping bag, pillow, blanket
- Torch
- Warm night wear (I suggest trackies/sweat shirt)
- Medication in clearly labelled container given to tutor

Other stuff...

- Lunch box and drinks container
- Notebook and pencil
- 2 black bin bags for wet and dirty clothes
- Small rucksack for day use
- Packed lunch for first day

Don't bring these things...

- Due to the outdoor aspect of the camp, all items of clothing may get wet and/or muddy – please don't wear/bring new gear!
- A campsite is not a safe place for items such as mobile phones, i-pods, mp3 players etc.
- Usual school rules apply regarding knives, matches, lighters etc.
- There are no shops so don't bring any money
