Curriculum Challenge

OPTION 1

 Reduce the number of optional subjects pupils study in Key Stage Four from 4 to 3

 Use the time released to increase teaching time for the Core Subjects

Curriculum Challenge

- OPTION 2
- Start GCSEs in Year 9
- Maintain 4 optional subjects at Key Stage Four, but spaced over 3 years
- By spacing options over 3 years, increase total teaching time for Options and Core Subjects


