A LEVEL PROGRAMME

- You need to achieve a **Grade B** in the 4 subjects you wish to study at A-Level (a grade C is only accepted at the School's discretion), to study A Level English/Maths new **Grade 6** (5&4 is only accepted at the School's discretion).

- The normal expectation is for you to achieve a 'good pass grade' (5+) in GCSE English, however, there is provision for re-take GCSE English alongside the A-Level programme. You will study Maths if you have not yet achieved a 'good pass grade' (5+) at GCSE.
- If you have not previously studied a subject, then your grades in a related subject or your English/Maths grade will be used.
- You need to have achieved at least 5 A*- C grades overall (or equivalent new 9-1 grades).

BTEC LEVEL 3 PROGRAMME

- You need to achieve at least 5 grade C or above to enrol on the BTEC Programme
- The normal expectation is for you to achieve a grade C in GCSE English, however, there is provision for re-take GCSE English alongside the BTEC programme. You will study Maths if you have not yet achieved a grade C or above at GCSE.
- The Standard BTEC programme consists of 3 subjects in Year 12.
- If you have not previously studied a subject, then your grades in related subject or your English/Maths grade will be used.
