In areas where close proximity cannot be avoided screens have been put in place, for example main reception. One-way system in place to avoid crowding in corridors. Wherever possible classrooms will operate a one way in and one way out directly to outside to disperse students quickly and avoid corridor congestion. Revaluation units will be out of use and top up of accounts to be done online. Thumb units to be wiped by canteen staff after every use. After each bubble have used the canteen the staff will clean the tables. Queues will be carefully managed to avoid crowding.	Yes	Severity 4 Likelihood 2 Risk Rating 8
