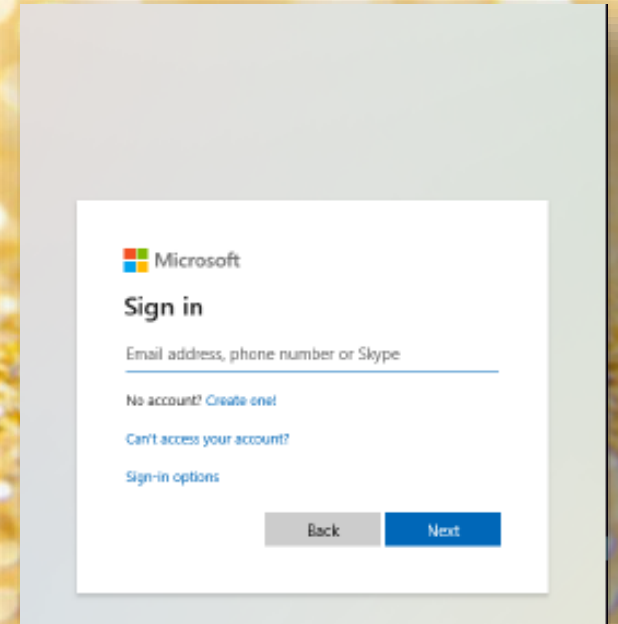

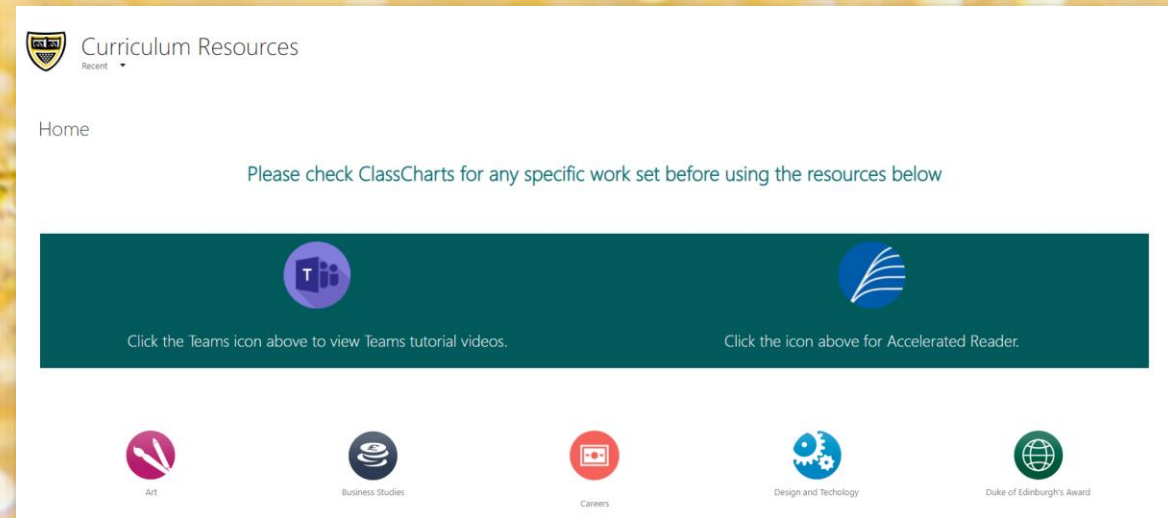
Enter your log-in detail as requested. (Most Likely your school email & password)

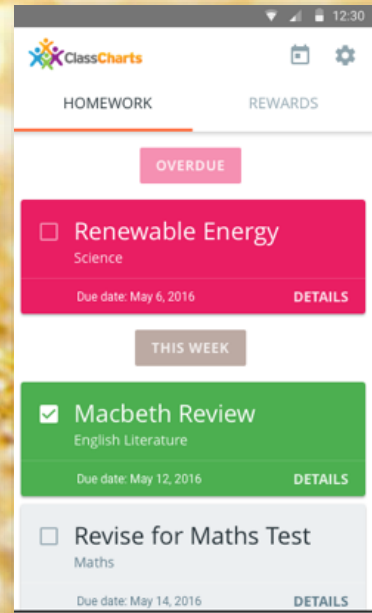
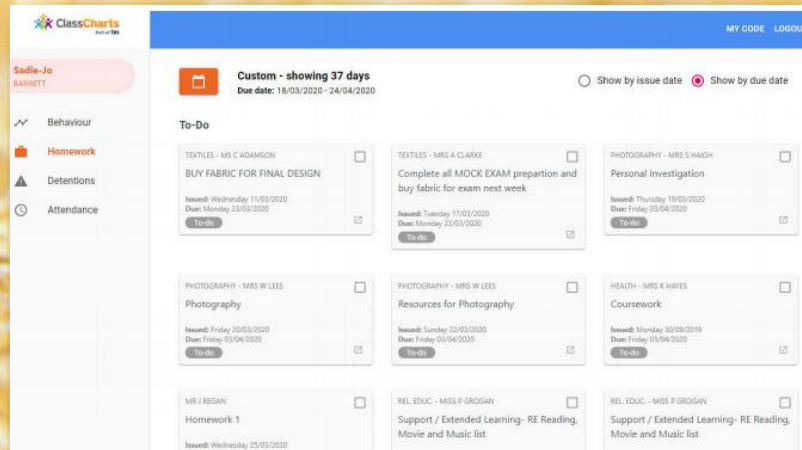


# ClassCharts



- You can access ClassCharts through your internet browser, or by downloading an app onto your device.
- Log in using your Pupil Code (your tutor can give you this if you forget) and your date of birth.
- Parents can also access ClassCharts using their own parent code, where they can see behaviour points, homework and more.

# ClassCharts



It also shows behaviour points in the form of a pie chart. You can look for specific dates or scroll down for more details.

You can see when homework is due, or if there are any overdue tasks.





# Student Documents



- Your username is just your WS number (the same you use to access log-in to computers in school).
- The password is the same one you use the log-in to computers at school.
- You can use the site to access your school documents and the school shared drive..
- You can download work to access.
- If you download and edit anything, remember to use the upload icon at the top to load back into your space in school.

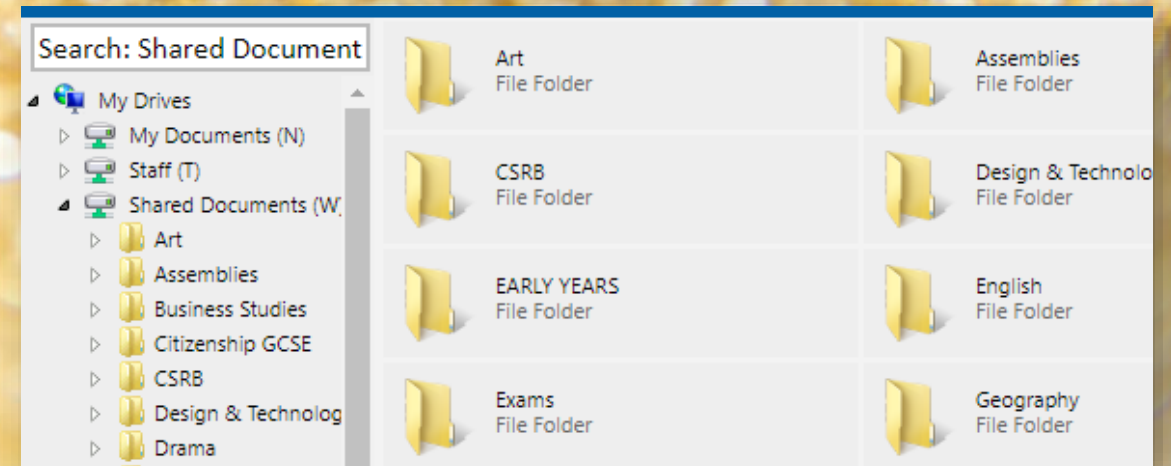

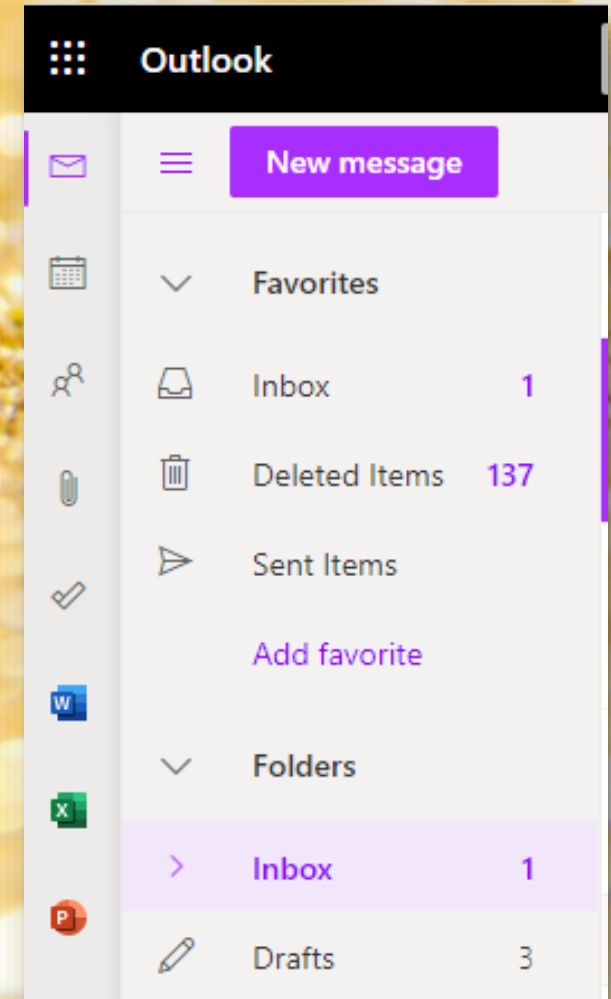




# School Email

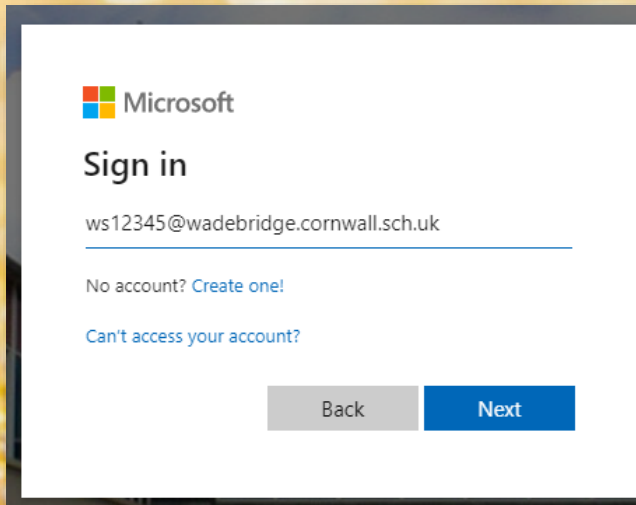


- Your email address is your WS number followed by @wadebridge.cornwall.sch.uk
- Example: [ws12345@wadebridge.cornwall.sch.uk](mailto:ws12345@wadebridge.cornwall.sch.uk)
- Once you have logged on you can use the list down the side to compose a new message and attach work.
- You can use the Sent Items to check something has been sent.
- Your teachers should tell you their email address in any homework posts, otherwise it's their first initial and surname.
- E.g. lwilmott@wadebridge.cornwall.sch.uk

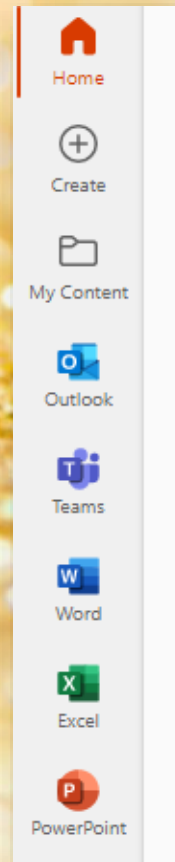




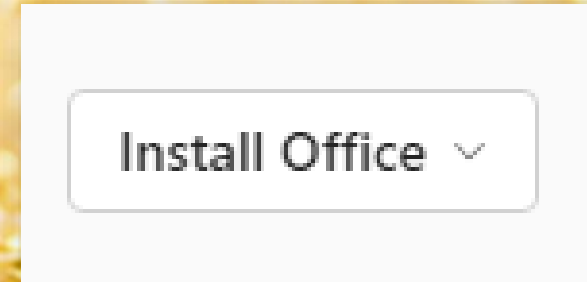

Log-in using your school email and password.



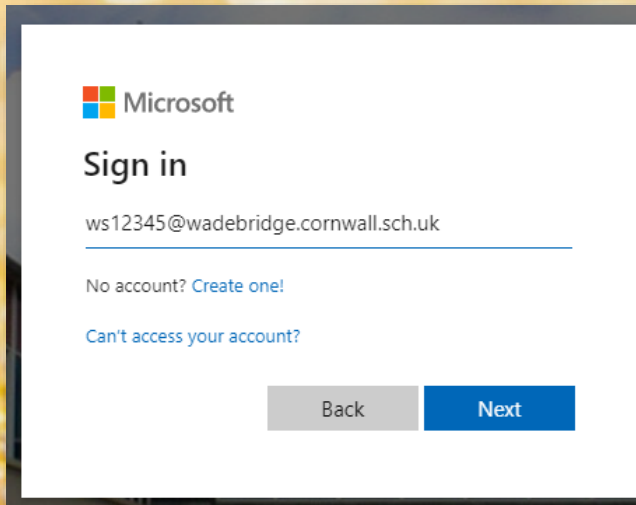
Use the icons on the left to access the different online apps.



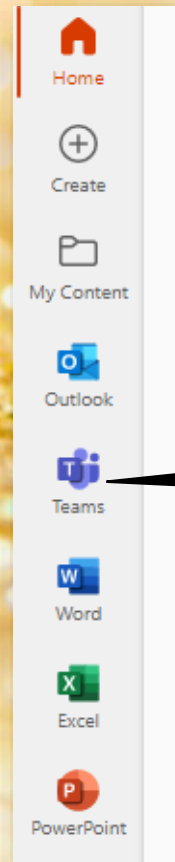
Use Install Office if you prefer to install on your computer to use.

Use Install Office if you prefer to install on your computer to use.



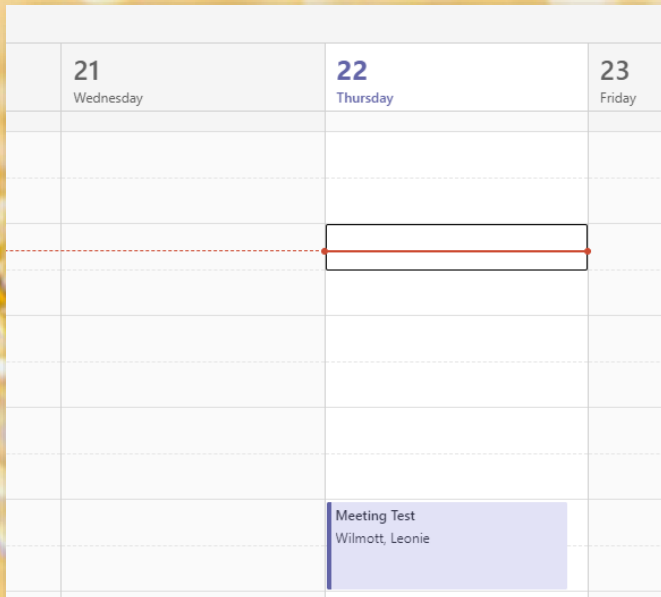
Use the icons on the left to click the TEAMS icon.



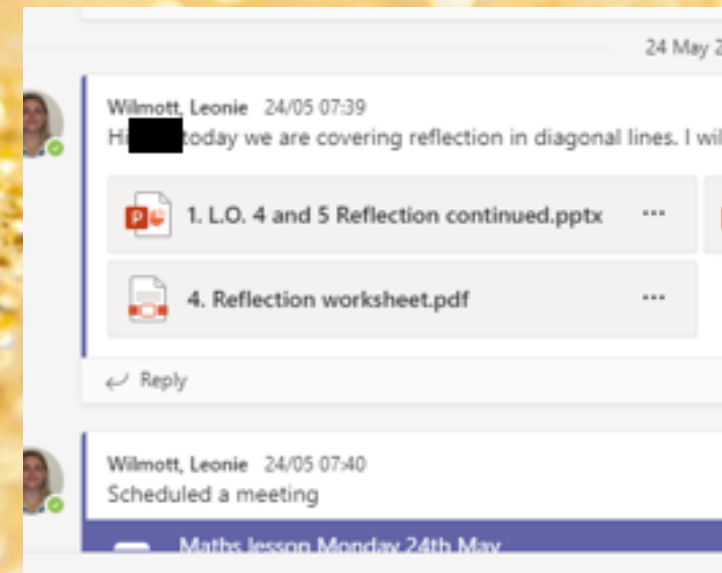
# Microsoft Teams



Teams is the application which teachers will use to deliver live lessons when either they have to work from home or any pupils are unable to attend school.



You will receive an email inviting you to a meeting, and it will appear in your calendar.



You can also use Teams to access any resources your teacher may have attached, and also submit your work and receive feedback.
