
School Email

- Your teachers should tell you their email address in any homework posts, otherwise it's their first initial and surname.

ClassCharts






- You can access ClassCharts through your internet browser, or by downloading an app onto your device.
- Log in using your Pupil Code (your tutor can give you this if you forget) and your date of birth.
- Parents can also access ClassCharts using their own parent code, where they can see behaviour points, homework and more.
- You can use ClassCharts to upload any work you complete.

You can see when homework is due, or if there are any overdue tasks.

It also shows behaviour points in the form of a pie chart. You can look for specific dates or scroll down for more details.




