

Defibrillator Awareness Training

In partnership with the local charity FLEET students and staff at Wadebridge School have been shown how to operate defibrillators that are becoming widely available across Cornwall towns and villages. Over the past two weeks all 1,150 students have been shown how these clever devices work. Somebody's chance of survival from a sudden cardiac arrest is improved significantly with the use of a defibrillator.
