

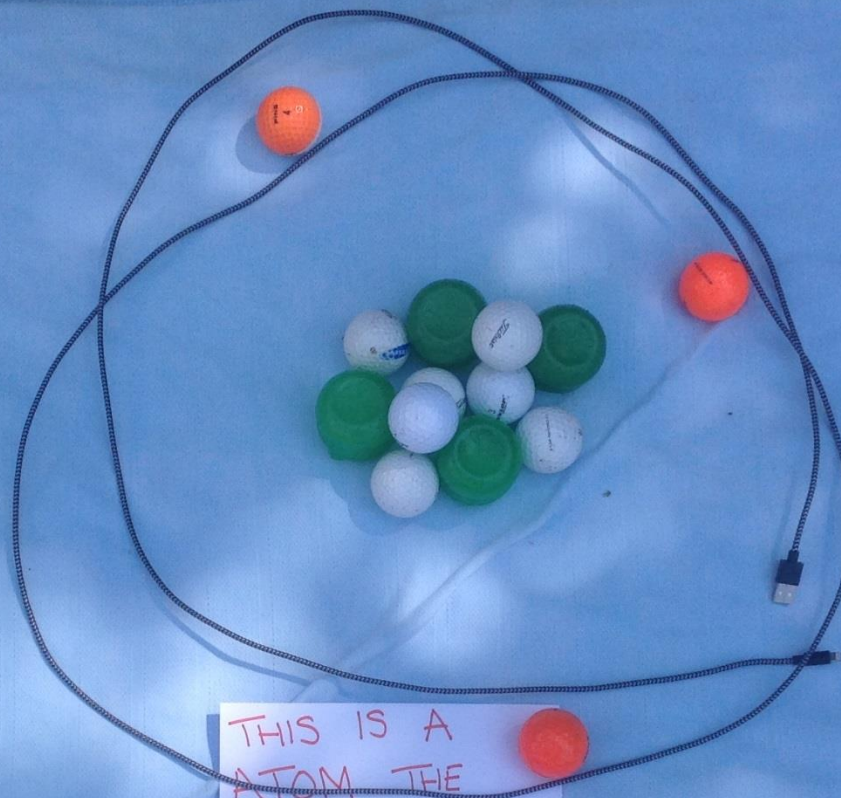

Atoms, Elements and Compounds

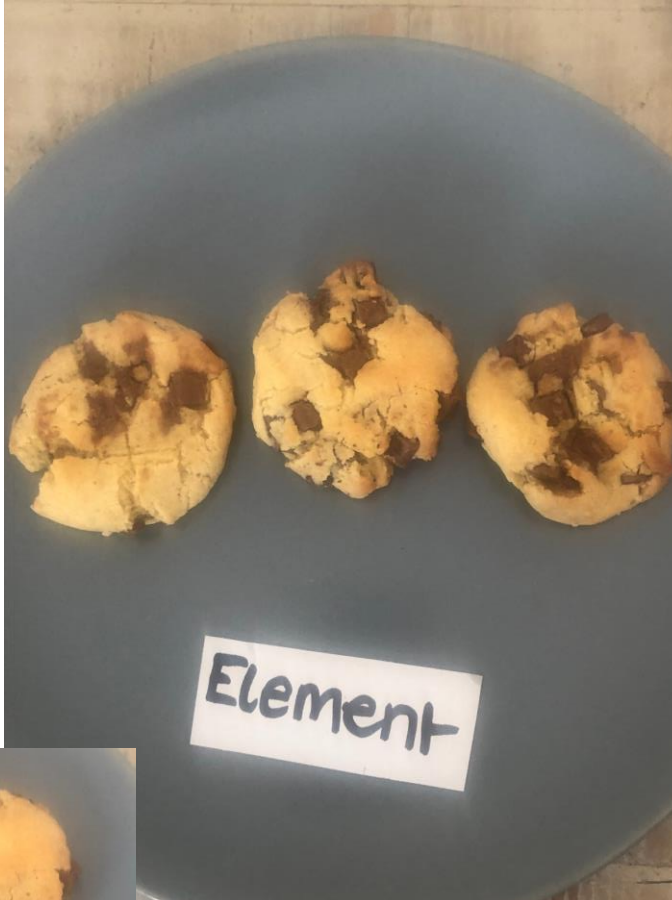
