

Power of 2 Intervention in Maths



What is Power of 2 intervention?

Power of 2 is a programme that enables pupils to access the full maths curriculum by putting in place the building blocks of number and by developing skills with mental calculations.

Who is it suitable for?

Power of 2 is ideal for students whose learning is assisted by repeated maths practice and is designed to be suitable for all age ranges. The clear language and repetition benefit students with dyslexia and those with English as an Additional language. Students with dyscalculia are helped by the highly structured approach with clear explanations.

What topics does the book cover?

Power of 2 begins with teaching number bonds to 10, and then moves on to introducing doubling, halving, addition and subtraction, rounding numbers, multiplying and dividing. It then progresses onto fractions and looks at worded problems and time.
