



# Picture Notes



## WHAT IS IT?

- Using pictures to help remember key words and key points of a topic.
- Pictures use your imagination so use a much deeper level of thinking than words alone.

## WHEN WOULD I USE IT?

- Draw a picture to remember key words (e.g. add them to your flash cards).
- Add pictures to mind-maps.
- Retell the life story of a historical/important person using only pictures.
- Show a scientific process using pictures.
- Show a key idea in images alone (fill a whole page – include 5 key words max!).
- Use caricatures to show qualities/characteristics of an important person.

## HOW DO I MAKE/USE ONE?

1. Use lots of colour – the brain prefers colourful objects to black-and-white ones.
2. Limit the number of words on a piece of work – e.g. 5 key words max – everything else must be shown in pictures!
3. Display colourful mind-maps/picture notes around your home (e.g. bedroom walls/cupboard doors) – this will help you remember them.
4. Show your picture notes to another person – can they work out what it's all about? Explain it to them – this is a great way to help you understand!






