What are the 5 Ps of safeguarding?

The 5 Ps of child protection are: Prevention, Paramountcy, Partnership, Protection and Parental Responsibility.

MARU

MARU (0300 123 1116 during the day or 01208 251 300 after 5pm and at weekends)

Keeping children safe is everyone's responsibility. If you have concerns about the safety of a child or young person, it is appropriate for you to contact the MARU advice line to discuss your concerns. This advice applies to all children and young people, irrespective of whether they are living at home with their families, with carers or away from home.

Early Help Hub (EHH)

The 'front door' to Early Help services led by Cornwall Council and Cornwall Foundation Trust. Staff within the Early Help Hub will decide whether the child / young person is eligible for support and which service is most appropriate. This is usually in discussion with the person making the request and / or young person / family.
