- 2. **Elderly care/end of life care** (care in hospices/hospitals; dying at home; who does the caring? What would you want?)
- 3. Assisted dying (Who? Why? Where? When?)
- 4. **NHS staff shortages**, e.g. nurses/midwives/GPs (what are the problems? How could it be improved? What are the government doing about the problems?)
- 5. **Mental Health crisis in the UK (**lack of staff, lack of funding, issues faced by teenagers, etc)

.....and produce a report (approx 2 sides of A4) which includes

- An outline of the **key issues** within the topic
- Your opinions on the key issues (your work is not complete unless this is included)
- Other peoples' opinions on the key issues (your work is not complete unless this is included)

NHS: National Health Service

GP: General Practitioner (your local doctor)

Service user: any member of the public who uses health & social care

services

Practitioner: a person working in a caring role in either health or social care or early years.
