Dear Parents and Carers

As I am sure you're aware, the Government announced yesterday that all schools are to close to students from the end of the day on Friday 20th March 2020 until further notice.

Schools have been asked to remain open for those students whose parents are "key workers" and the examples given were: NHS, Police or supermarket delivery drivers. This may be clarified further as we go through the day.

Schools have also been asked to provide supervision for students who may be extremely vulnerable, for example those with EHCPs or who have a social worker.

Whilst providing learning resources for students working from home and supervision for students who need to be in school can be managed, I am asking for your help in providing information so that we can plan effectively.

If you are a key worker or care for a vulnerable child and **<u>need</u>** them to come into school, please reply to this e-mail or send to <u>enquiries@wadebridge.cornwall.sch.uk</u> with the information below.

- 1. Your job and employer
- 2. Child's name and Tutor Group
- 3. Whether they need access to a school bus and the bus number that they have a pass for
- 4. Whether your child will bring a packed lunch or need food provided by the canteen

We will then be able to communicate with the appropriate teams and plan a way forward.
