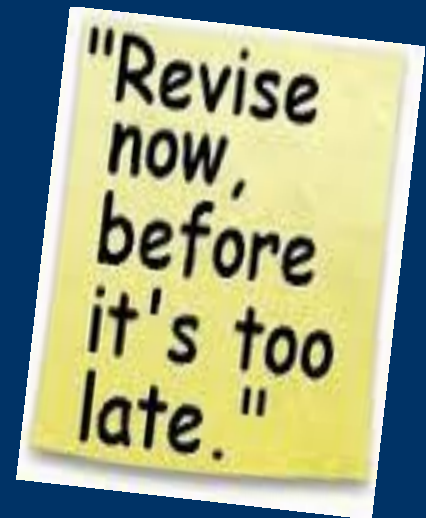

- *Have the correct equipment*

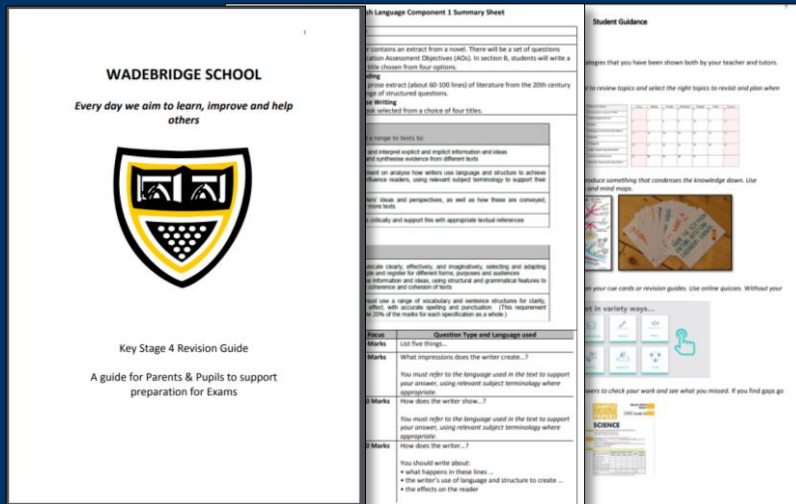

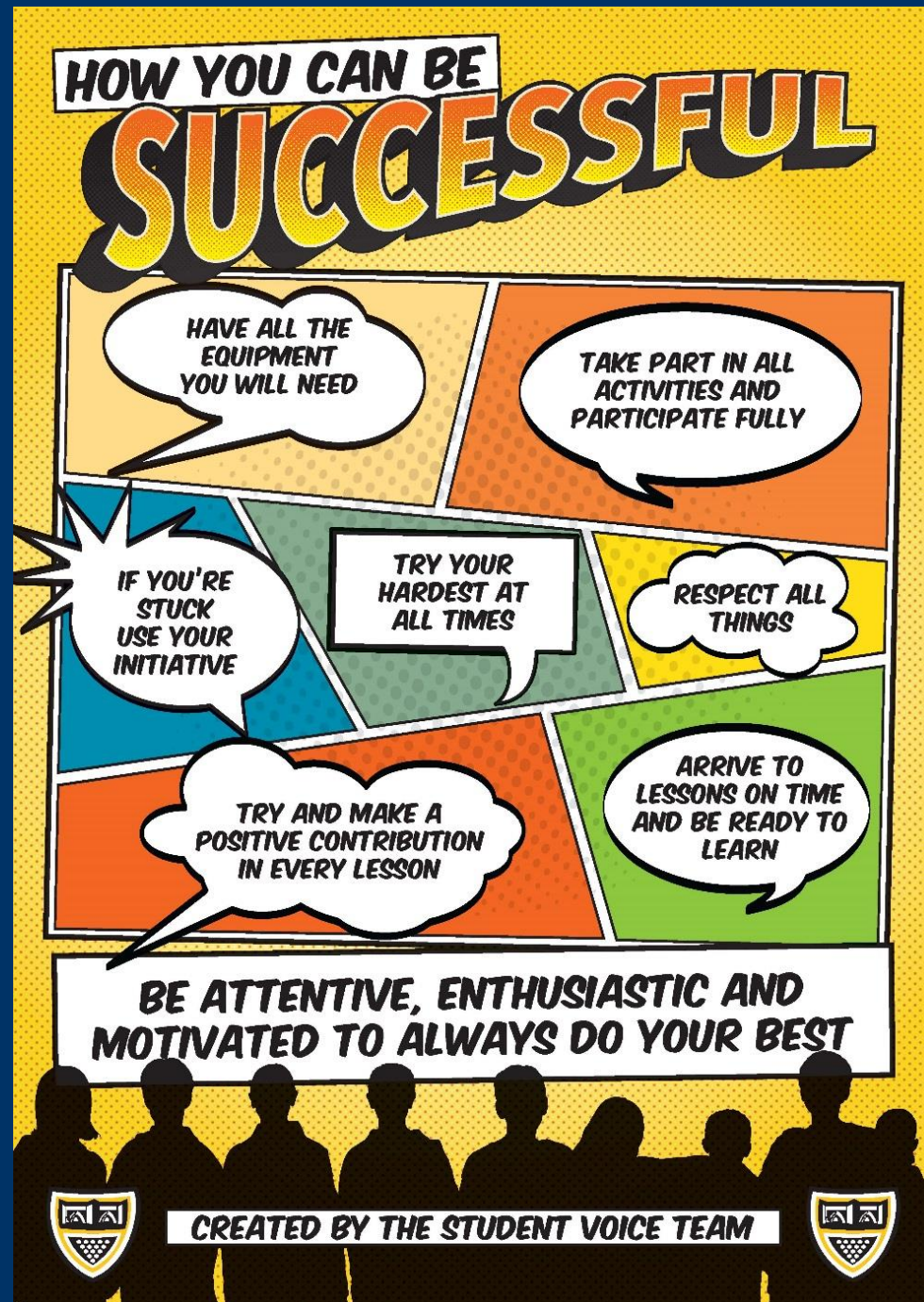
# Work Experience


Visit Mr Bateman at registration to change for a suitable pair

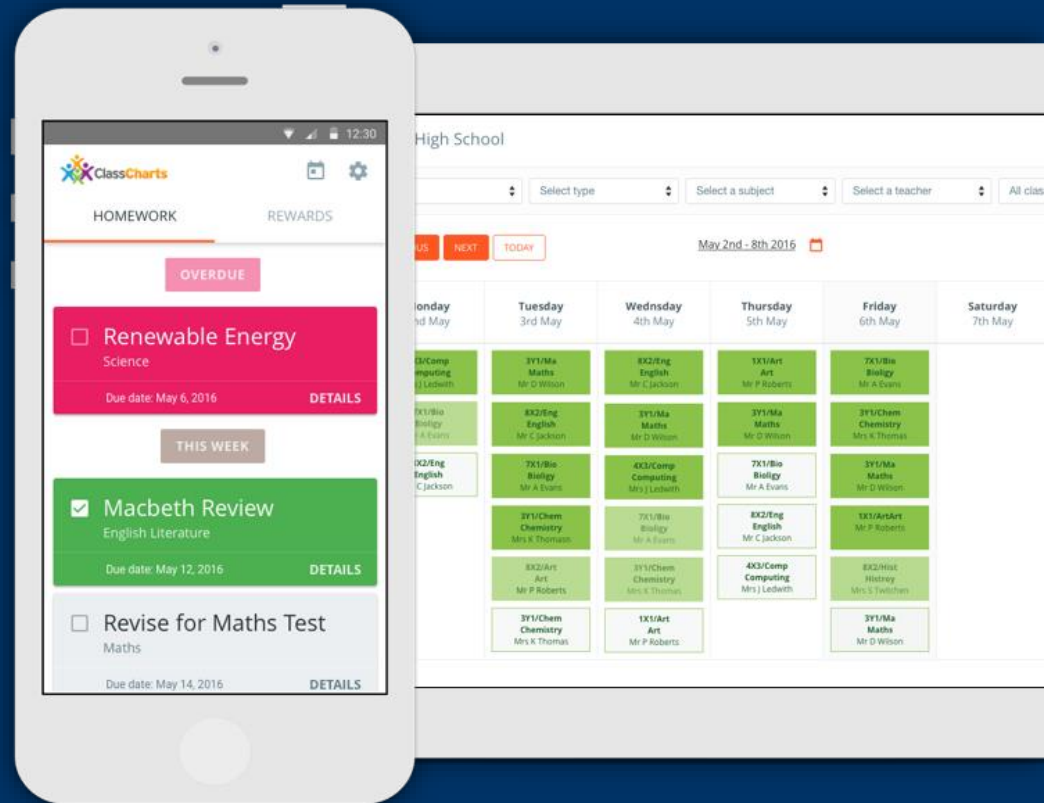

# Homework

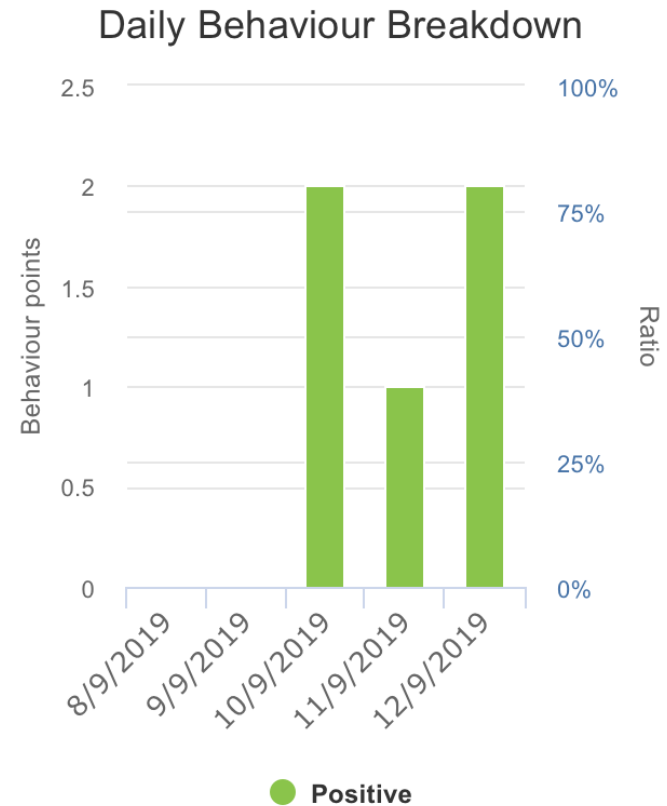
- Homework will now be set within ClassCharts and **NOT** ShowMyHomework.
